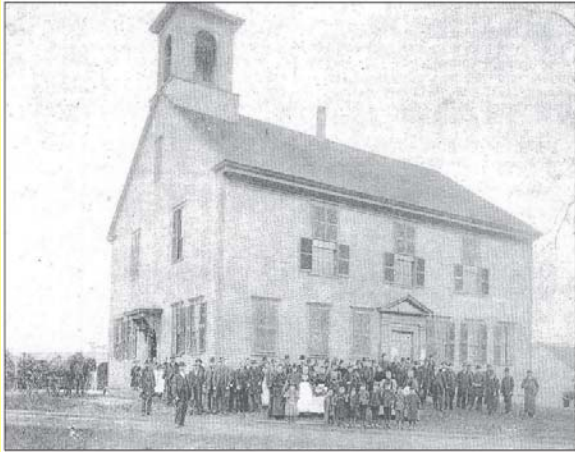

## History of Old Yellow Meeting House

The building was originally built in 1794 as the Centre Church and Town Meeting House. It is located at the geographical center of the town and is considered the town of Dracut's most significant landmark.

The Old Yellow Meeting House is currently owned by Christ Church United Dracut which was established in 1969 as a merger of the First Parish Congregational Church (Old Yellow Meeting House) and the First Evangelical Church (Hillside). Both churches had their roots in the first congregational society founded in Dracut in 1711.
